Weight relief of the heel/-s when supine lying:



1. If the Master Comfort Heel is placed with the larger canal under the Achilles tendon, full weight relief is achieved. At the same time hyperextension of the knee joints is prevented. Adjust the filling to fit the leg's cavaties.



2. If Master Comfort Heel is placed with the smallest canal under the Achilles tendon, a partial weight relief is achieved, so the heel still has lightly contact with the sheet. Ideal for users with dementia or who is perceptual impaired.



3. If weight relief is only needed on one heel, the Master Comfort Heel - S can be used with advantage.

Side and prone lying:



4. Master Comfort Heel can be used with advantage if the user is positioned side lying with parallel legs. Place it with the small canal closest to the feet.



5. If the pillow is slightly displaced backwards, it gives an increased sense of stability when positioning the user.



6. If the user is lying in a prone position, place the Master Comfort Heel so it supports both shin and foot.

7. A soft, comfortable and washable cover is available to protect the cushion.



8. Master Comfort Sleep consistes of real Krøyer balls which addabed to the body and give the body a sense of stability and a good pressure relief.
